There are so many people we want to thank. Thank you to our incredible auction committee that was led by Tanja Heuscher. The auction team works diligently for 10+ months to pull off this memorable event. This team has a passion for TLS and for this event. 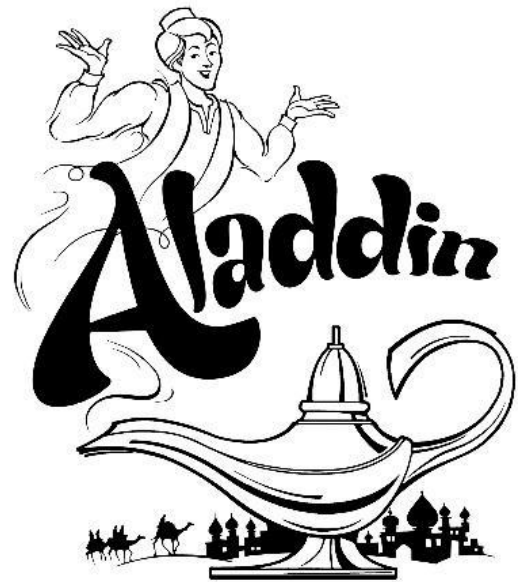
