#### Principal's Corner

I'm sure you've done this, you lay your phone down somewhere and you forget where you put it. On the table where you put the mail? In the car? In your pocket or purse? You have checked all your usual places, but it's not there, and you forget where you put it!

I, I am the one who forgives all your sins, I do this to please myself, I will not remember your sins. Isaiah 43:25

This passage speaks of God not remembering, only in this case it is a critical situation. Here He tells His rebellious people about their sins - that He will not remember them! He is full of forgetfulness. Does He really mean it? What comfort we have in knowing that God forgets our sins! He cites a phrase familiar to what a parent's retort might be to a demanding child. He begins His pronouncement, in effect by saying, "Because I said so! God enough for me. Good enough for me too."

Then He goes on about the reason for His forgetfulness - not old age, but to please Himself! It may be in vocabulary a bit unfamiliar to what we usually hear, but it's equivalent to the phrase "for Jesus' sake or "for My sake." In short, He forgives us because He loves us, even to the point of sending His Son Jesus to pay the penalty for our sins. And to top it off, He doesn't archive our sins and keep track of them to hold it against us in the future.

At Trinity we are blessed to be able to freely speak of the love and forgiveness of Jesus!
