Thank you for entrusting us with your children! It is such a blessing to be able to share Jesus with your children throughout the day. I see glimpses of this as I pass through classrooms. Prayer is a prominent way for teachers to impact the lives of the students. Often I hear teachers telling a student she will pray for them, or praying with the students right in the moment. When I have students who have had a disagreement with another student and they are able to say, "I'm sorry and I forgive you." Often, I hear students using these same words on their own without being prompted by an adult. These are important lessons of love and faith.

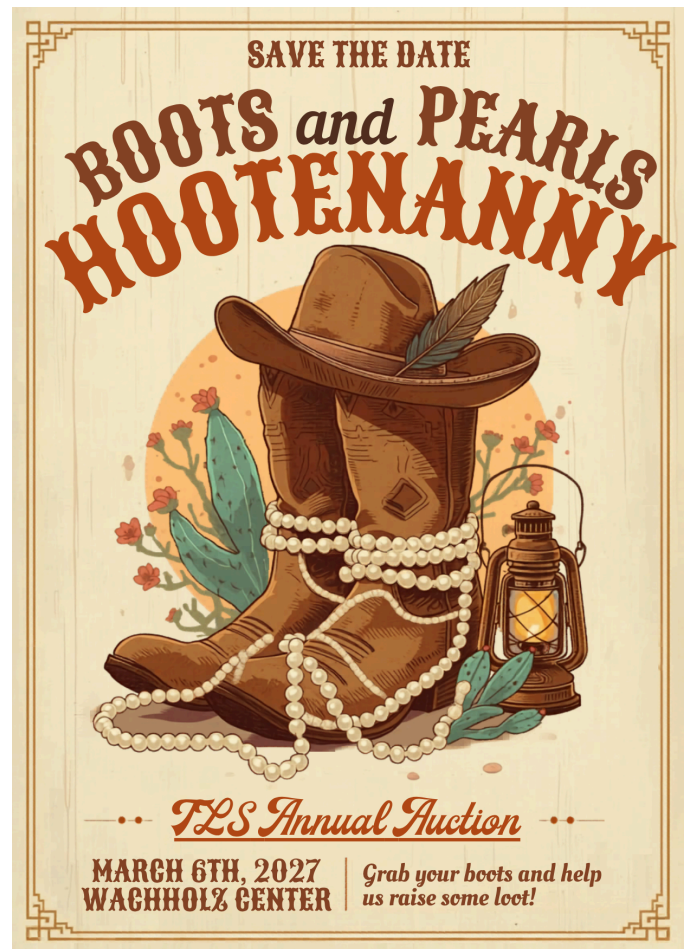

What is a 529 Savings Plan?

A Section 529 qualified tuition program (529 plan) is a tax-advantaged savings program designed to help you save for college. You can use the assets held in your 529 account to pay for your beneficiary's tuition, fees, books, and certain room and board costs, not only in Montana, but at eligible schools anywhere around the country.
