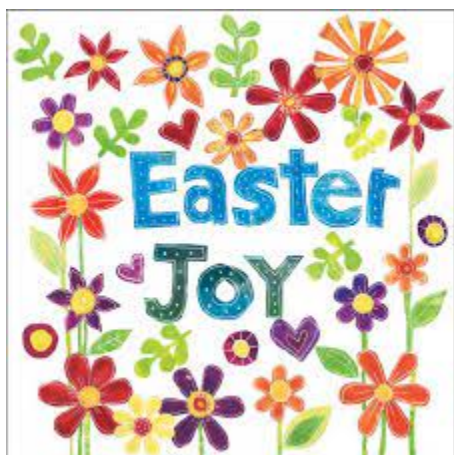

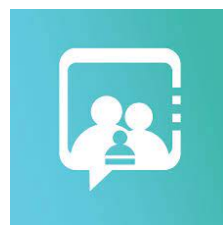
This coming week we will be lifting up our 8th grade students, their families and Mrs. Elliott in prayer.

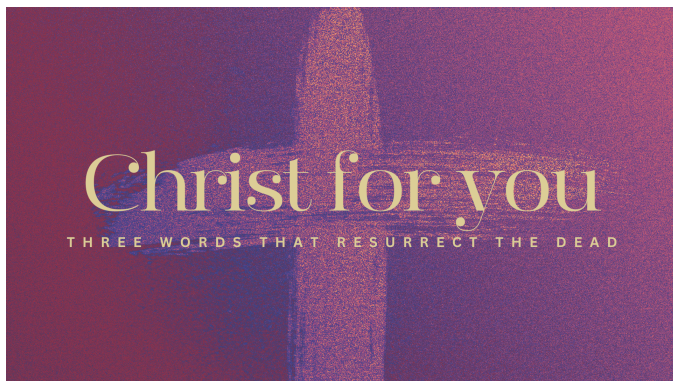
