Wednesday, February 14 is not only Valentine's Day, but it is also Ash Wednesday. What a perfect combination to celebrate Jesus' love for us and to be reminded of the tremendous sacrifice that was given for you and me.

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is a 40 day period (excluding Sundays) and is a time of preparation for Easter marked by repentance and reflection that ultimately leads up to the celebration of Easter.

During chapel on Wednesday, we will acknowledge and celebrate Ash Wednesday by offering to place a cross on the forehead of the children and teachers. We give students the option to have the cross on their foreheads or on their hand.

The ashes are typically obtained by burning the palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday. The imposition of ashes is often accompanied by the words, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Lent is a time for personal reflection and repentance. Often people talk about giving something up for the season of Lent. This tradition was started with fasting on select days during Lent. This has evolved to giving up something that is important to the individual. Maybe this would be desserts, chocolate, soda, or social media. In recognition of the sacrifice Jesus made for us, individuals make a personal sacrifice. In past years I have given up peanut butter, diet coke or chocolate.

Lent can also be a time to be more diligent about studying God's word and being in prayer. For me this year, instead of taking something away, I am going to add to my prayer time and to the reading of God's word.
