

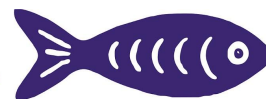

Principal's Corner

As we end quarter one, you and your student can look back to evaluate how he/she did. The report card and test scores are ways we are able to track your student's progress. This is just one measurement and one indicator of success. Progress, relationships and respect can be another indicator.

Is your student making progress and moving forward? This can be evaluated based on goals. Goals can look differently for the age of the student but they could include completing and sharing the DLL (daily learning log), reading 3 nights per week as a family, or turning in 100% of their work on time. Having grit during hard times is also an important quality of a successful student.

Is your student kind to classmates and siblings? This is another indicator of a successful, happy, well rounded student.

Is your student respectful to parents, adults and teachers? These are skills that your child will use into adulthood.

If you have dinner as a family three times a week, your kids will remember that you ate dinner together.

If you read aloud three times a week, your kids will grow up remembering that you read to them.

If you go for a walk three times a week, you're someone who walks!

Set realistic, attainable goals for you and your family as we move into the 2nd quarter.
