Principal's Corner

At Trinity, we practice continuous enrollment. That means your student is enrolled from one grade to the next until they graduate from 8th grade or your family officially withdraws. This will be an easy process that will save you time and paperwork.

This continuous enrollment process will happen through your TADS account and will begin on **March 6**. As a valued member of our Trinity family, you will receive a discount on your registration fees from March 6 -12. On March 13 the registration fees will reset to the amount.

Registration will open to the public on March 13 and we anticipate all classes being full or nearly full for the 2023-2024 school year. It is important for you to complete your TADS enrollment between March 6-12 for two reasons.

1. You will secure a spot in your child's class.
2. You will save money on your registration fees.

Pre-k families who wish to enroll in kindergarten will be sent an email from TADS with a link for enrollment.

Please mark **March 6** on your calendar. We don't want anyone to miss out!



SALT Opportunities

Each family (K-8th) is asked to serve 25 volunteer hours each year. This can also be donated to the school at a rate of \$20/hour.

Half of your SALT hours (12.5 hours = \$250) were due by January 31. If not complete, your TADS account was charged and added to your February payment. Any unfinished second half of your SALT will be assessed in May and added to your TADS account in June.

4H Archery Tournament

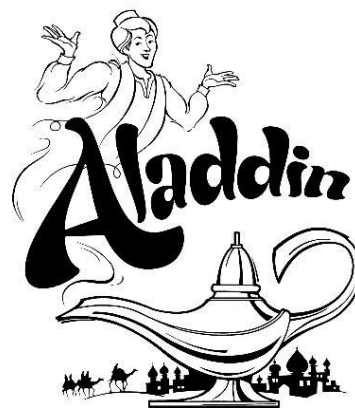
Some of our Trinity students participated in an archery tournament at the fairgrounds this past weekend.
