When you work, do you like it completely quiet, or do you like some noise in the background? If you like noise, would this be quiet instrumental music, music with words or white noise like a rain, wind or a waterfall?

There is no right or wrong answer and for you it may vary depending on your activity. If I need to really focus, I need music without words. If I'm cooking or doing something creative, I like music with words. If it has been a busy, noisy day, sometimes I just want it to be completely quiet.

The same is true for your student whether in the classroom or at home.

Research shows promise for children with reading disabilities and those with ADHD. In two separate studies, both conclude that white noise shows benefit for children who struggle with decoding and those with ADHD.

Most people have heard of white noise. It's noise that is just dull in the background. There are also several colors of noise. Green noise is basically nature sounds. Brown noise contains low tones and is good for relaxing.

You may consider adding some background noise for your child when they are doing their school work. Take note if there are noticeable changes in your child's ability to focus.

Many of our classrooms will play music, or nature sounds at various times throughout the day. Our teachers are so good at knowing when it would be an appropriate time to add a little noise to help students focus.


