First Day of School

We will have chapel on the first day of school (August 30) at 8:20am. All parents are invited to attend along with your child. This is such a great way to kick off our school year!

Blue Polos

Blue Polos will **not** be required on the first day of school. The church is going through a process of acquiring a new logo. We were hopeful this logo would be available for shirts before the start of school, but no luck. The plan is for the school to purchase iron-on logos that we can pass onto our families. In the meantime, we recommend you purchase a navy blue polo from Old Navy, JCPenney, Gap, Target, Walmart or Lands End. It will be ok if the shirt doesn't have a logo at the start of school. We will accept the old logo design so students can wear their shirt from last year.

Volleyball

Volleyball for girls in 5th - 8th grade will begin on Thursday, August 31 immediately following school. Students should wear shorts and a t-shirt and bring a water bottle for practice.

Dress Code

- No hats in the building.
- Straps on shirts must be 4 fingers wide.
- If the student raises their hands over their head, no midriff will show.
- Shorts are fingertip length.
- Blue polos are to be worn all day on chapel days (With the exception of the first and last day of school).
- Jeans without holes in them can be worn.

Drop off and Pick-up

The school doors will open at 7:55am and class starts at 8:10am. Students can be dropped off at the main church doors and enter by the back hallway or parents are also welcome to park and walk their child into class.

Attendance

Attendance is an indicator of student success. It is important for your child to be in school and on time every day.

Please note Trinity's attendance policy:

Trinity Lutheran School's academic program is designed to support in-person instruction. When a student is frequently absent, undue strain is placed on the learning experience for the student, the class, and the teacher

Students who are absent more than 20 days in one academic year (or 20 periods from the same class) for any reason other than school-sanctioned events may be asked to leave Trinity because of the stress the absences place on the Trinity community. When the student has reached 10 absences, the family will be required to meet with the classroom teacher and the principal. Failure to meet after 10 absences will put your student's enrollment in jeopardy.

Please keep this in mind when scheduling appointments and vacations during the school year.

GoGuardian

Trinity has adopted GoGuardian, a platform for monitoring student devices. This will be used in our middle school. Our teachers will receive training before the start of school and you will certainly hear more about this at the start of school.

Parent Pulse

As Trinity grows, it is important to us to continue to improve. One way for us to improve is to keep lines of communication open with our families. Parent Pulse is one avenue we will use to continue to listen to our families and strive for excellence. Through Parent Pulse, you will receive brief surveys quarterly. It is through this feedback we will be able to keep a close eye on how we are serving our families. We are looking forward to the outcomes.
