





All parents know that reading to their children is important and helps with early literacy. However, a recent study shows that only ½ of children nationwide under the age of 4 are read to.

For some parents, reading was always a chore and something to be rushed through for a grade requirement. They never learned to take time to enjoy a book they were interested in. As a result, the love of reading was never passed down to the child.

Students who are not read to before entering school will undoubtedly have less success in school than those who are read to on a regular basis.

Many parents stop reading to their children when the child learns to read. Continuing the practice of reading out loud all through elementary school will greatly benefit the child. They will:

1. Become better listeners.
2. Gain vocabulary as they can understand a book over their reading level.
3. Grow the bond between the child and parent as they share this commonality over a book.
4. Learn empathy from the characters in the books and allow conversations with the parent to flow outward from the content in the book.
