

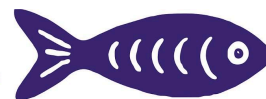

Have you ever had one of those days where it seems like nothing is going right? Your alarm clock was set for p.m. instead of a.m., then you poured your coffee on your cereal instead of milk. After pouring yourself a new cup of coffee in a secure travel mug, you leave it on the roof of your car. Uff da, is your day ruined? Do you head back home, pull the shades and crawl back into bed and wait for a redo? Do you chuckle about it and marvel that things can only get better as you continue your day?

How you, as a parent, handle mishaps will affect how your child handles mishaps. Your mindset matters.

You can help your child work through adversity.

- 1) Set a good example by not grumbling when things go wrong.
- 2) Remind your child that sometimes things are out of their control.
- 3) Help your child to find the good in a situation.

To help children work through hard times, it's also important to not always rescue them. Because we love our children, we don't want them to experience hard things or for them to experience pain. Keep in mind, when your child has to learn from a mistake this is how they grow.




Spiritwear Available
