This week all of our families received an email with enrollment information for the 2024-2025 school year. Included with this email were tuition and fees for the coming year.

It is tough to have to raise tuition. We don't want to price anyone out of Trinity. We always look for a balance between rising costs, paying our teachers a fair wage and offering affordable tuition. Please know that Trinity offers scholarships for those who need a little help to close the gap.

At Trinity, we practice "Continuous Enrollment." This means that your student will be enrolled until there is an official withdrawal.

There are a few tasks that have to be completed to have your child officially re-enrolled. On March 4, you will receive an email from TADS with a link to complete your enrollment.

- 1. We ask that parents verify **all** information in TADS.
- 2. Then complete the enrollment by paying the registration fee. All accounts must be current in order to complete this process.

Families who complete the registration process between March 4-10 will save \$50 off their registration fee per student. Registration fees will return to the full amount on March 11.

It is anticipated that classes will fill up quickly so, please don't delay your registration. We don't want anyone to miss out.

As we make plans for the 2024-2025 school year we look forward to all that God has planned for Trinity.


Re-enrollment runs March 4-10


