

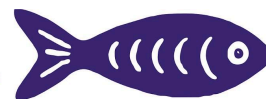

This coming Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season which is the 40 days leading up to Easter. Chapel on Ash Wednesday will be led by Pastor Brian and during chapel, the students will have an opportunity to receive ashes on their forehead. As the ashes are placed on the student, these words are shared, "From dust you are and from dust you shall return and from dust you will rise again." This reminds us of our own mortality, but also the hope we have in the resurrection.

During Lent, you hear people talking about what they will be giving up between the time of Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday. Chocolate, desserts or candy might be some of the more common choices. Others might give up social media, a stop at the coffee shop or energy drinks. Have you considered what you could give up for the season of Lent? We give something up during Lent in recognition of the sacrifice Jesus made for each of us. Jesus gave his life as a sacrifice for each one of us because of the tremendous love he has for us. We don't give something up to draw attention to us, but to focus on Jesus. Will you be giving something up this season?

Maybe instead of giving something up, we add something that will draw up closer to Jesus. How about adding prayer time while you go for a walk? Consider praying with your children in the car on the way to school or adding in a family devotion time.

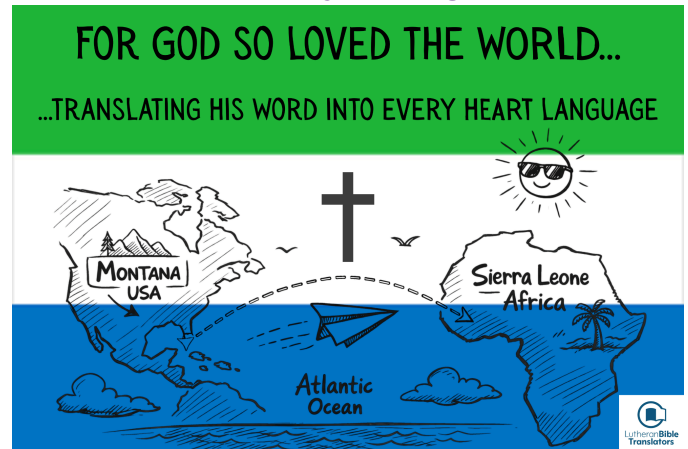
Lent is a time to focus our thoughts on Jesus and what he has done for us. What a blessing it is that we get to share these conversations with your children.

New Classes for the 2026-2027 School year

We are excited to announce our new Early Childhood Learning Classes at Trinity Lutheran School. We offer a fun, happy place full of opportunities to explore our world with hands-on learning in a safe, nurturing Christ-centered environment. Each child is valued as an individual learner who is full of ideas and eager to learn.

Little Learners - *This class is for children who are 3 years old by September 10 and potty trained.* These Little Learners will explore the world around them through play, and hands-on learning. Little Learners will be introduced to Jesus and His love for them.

Pre-K - *This class is for children who are 4 years old by September 10th and are potty-trained.* Our Pre-K class learn through play, observation, investigation, and Bible Stories.

Jr. Kindergarten - *Jr. Kindergarten is for children who are 4 and/or 5 years old.* Sometimes the step between Pre-K into Kindergarten can be a big leap. Jr. Kindergarten offers a nice in-between step. The student's faith will grow as Jesus is integrated into all their learning.

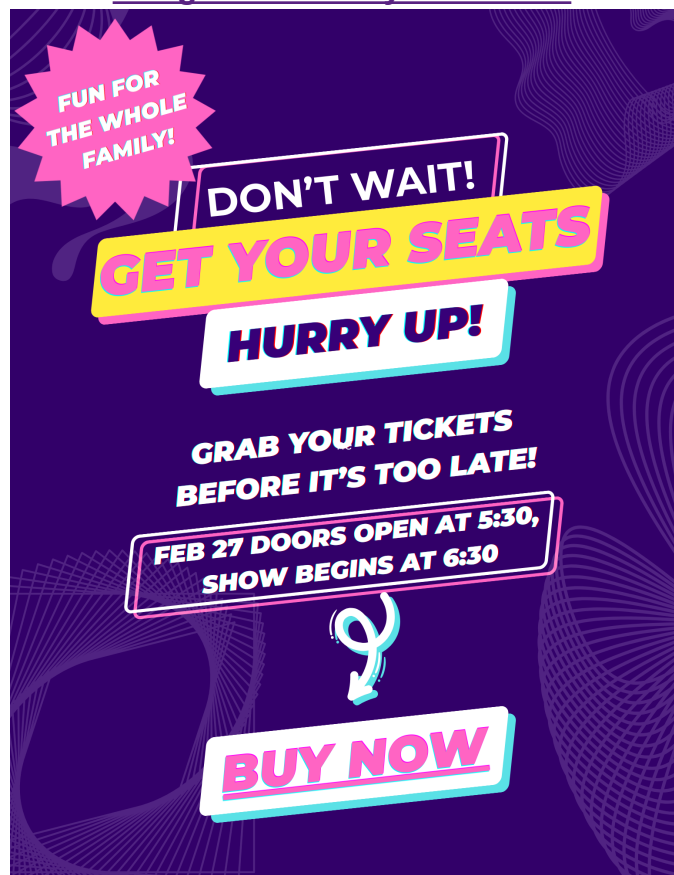

PROGRAM INFORMATION

APPLICATION OPEN FEB. 2 – APRIL 15, 2026

➔ **WHO WE ARE**
 Our vision is that every child has access to a quality education. Since 2012, ACE has provided 11,459 scholarships to children from lower-income families totaling \$24,908,049 and teamed up with approximately 40 partner schools across the state.

➔ **WHAT WE DO**
 Our mission is to advance K-12 educational freedom, with a focus on securing financial support for families so they may access the quality education of their choice.

➔ **QUALIFICATIONS FOR STUDENTS**
 ACE scholarships are based solely on the family's total income both taxable (line 9 on the 1040 for those who file) and nontaxable. See the chart below for ACE Scholarships' financial eligibility breakdown by household size.

➔ **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNTS**
 ACE scholarships are partial tuition, intended to provide the added assistance lower-income families may need to enroll their child in a private school. Standard ACE award amounts are \$3,000 for K-8 and \$4,000 for high school (9-12). Awards are capped at 50% of the school's listed annual tuition. Families are responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition.

THE ACE MODEL

Changing Education Changes Everything

➔ **PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS**
 A wide variety of private schools participate in the ACE scholarships program. It is up to the families of potential scholarship recipients to determine the school that is the best fit for their child.

➔ **AN ACE SCHOLARSHIP CAN FOLLOW YOUR CHILD**
 If your child is awarded a scholarship, those funds are portable if transferred before funds are sent to the school and may be used at any ACE partner private school. So, if the private school you select ends up not being the right fit, you can transfer your child to another private school, and the scholarship goes with them.

➔ **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

The application for an ACE scholarship is completed online at <https://portal.acescholarships.org/ace>

 Families of students provided a scholarship the prior year will be charged a \$10 fee per application whereas applicants who do not have a student receiving a scholarship in the prior year will be charged a \$25 fee. The application will be open Monday, February 2, 2026 through Wednesday, April 15, 2026 at 11:59 pm (in the time zone the school resides).

FOR FAMILIES NEW TO THE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

1. Identify the right ACE partner private school for your child. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child.
2. Confirm that you qualify for a scholarship based on the financial guidelines listed in the chart provided. Complete the ACE Scholarships application for your student(s). You must complete an application for ACE Scholarships separate from your school application.
3. Answer all application questions, attach required documentation, and submit. You may begin an application and save and return at any time. Applications must be complete and submitted before the April 15 deadline for the students to be considered for awarding.

FOR FAMILIES WITH A STUDENT CURRENTLY RECEIVING AN ACE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Complete the school's application and enrollment process for your child.
2. Complete the ACE Scholarships application for your student(s). You must complete an application for ACE Scholarships separate from your school application, but returning families **do not** need to requalify based on income. Simply answer all application questions, verify your information is correct, and submit. You may begin an application and save and return to your progress at any time, but applications must be complete and submitted before the April 15 deadline for the students listed on the application to be considered for awarding.
