

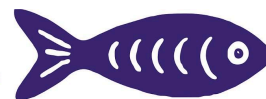

Have you heard of the summer slide? The summer slide is not a cool ride at an amusement park or a county fair. The summer slide is the academic decline that occurs when students are not engaged over the summer months.

For students who haven't been engaged in learning over the summer, the teacher has to spend time recapping to refresh brains and get ready for new learning topics.

Don't panic, this doesn't mean you have to turn the spare bedroom into a classroom. It means using teachable moments and limiting screen time.

1. Ask your child to choose age appropriate books to read over the summer. After your child has finished reading the book have them give a 5 minute recap on what the book was about.
2. Use some creativity to use everyday math skills. Calculate mileage on a road trip, add up menu items from a restaurant or estimate how much it would cost to travel by car to a specific destination. How many gallons of gas will it take? The possibilities are endless. Don't forget about math skills over the summer!
3. Get your children out in a garden. All ages of children can help with planting, weeding, harvesting and of course eating the crop.
4. Find an opportunity to learn outside of a classroom: FVCC has learning opportunities for students, visit a museum when you travel, take a hike, don't skip the visitor's center.
5. Do a DIY project - fix or build something. Paint or create something new.
6. Cook with your children. So much learning can take place through cooking. And the results are often so delicious!
7. Be outside and off of screens!

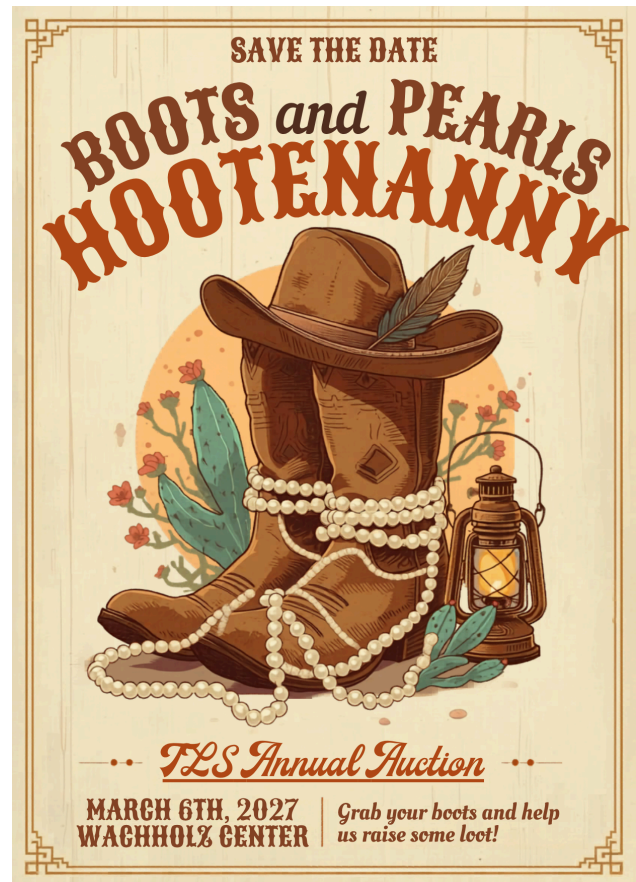
Hot Lunch
