We are not alone, through these schools, 180,000 students nationwide have the privilege of hearing about Jesus and his love for them. Here at Trinity, we currently serve 268 students and their families in pre-k through 8th grade.

Blue Polos

Students will no longer be required to wear their blue polo shirts on chapel days. We encourage students to dress nicely on chapel days but there are not specific requirements. There are several reasons for this change:

- There are very few extra shirts on the shirt rack and most are small sizes.
- When students forget their shirt, there are a limited number of extra shirts to borrow.

- It created something for teachers to monitor.

Our current dress code is:

- straps on shirts need to be four fingers wide.
- No midriff when hands are lifted over the child's head.
- hats are for outside
- No holes in jeans.




